

Testing Protocol: -- Things TO KNOW --

All considerations and nominations of juniors for dan promotion should be determined over long-term instruction and with dedicated observation by the instructor. **Impromptu notice and requests for dan testing at Summer Camp is PROHIBITED.**

- 1) All test applications and forms MUST be mailed IN TANDEM with Summer Camp registration forms. Absolutely <u>no</u> test applications will be processed after the postmark. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 2) **Direct Instructor's permission is REQUIRED.**
- 3) **<u>Proof of signature</u>** by direct instructor is **REQUIRED**.
- 4) Annual dues MUST be current and up to date with NASSK records for a minimum of <u>5 months</u> prior to test date. *Annual dues cannot be paid at Summer Camp and expect to be eligible to test.*
- Late submission of testing applications (indicated by postmark date) will be <u>forfeitted</u> by Sensei Mitsuzuka.
 Camp registration papers will <u>still</u> be processed with the addition of a \$50.00 late fee.
- 6) Please fill out and submit <u>1</u> copy of the "*Application for Dan Grades*" form, Please fill out and submit<u>3</u> copies of the "*Test Evaluation*" form.
 - 6a) Please write your name on the *Application for Dan Grades* form <u>as you would like it to appear on</u> <u>your certificate</u>. For example, choose between full name vs. nick name, middle initial, etc. No titles. **NOTE: Sensei charges** *double* for any re-issue of certificates for mistakes with names made by the applicant.
 - 6b) Please indicate ONLY your <u>Name</u>, <u>Member #</u>, <u>Present Rank</u> and <u>Rank testing for</u> on the *Test Evaluation* form.
- Please tender <u>one</u> payment for the appropriate Certificate Fee and <u>another</u> individual payment for the non-refundable Test Fee (\$25).
 (See "Dan Test Certicate Fees" chart for reference of Cerficate Fee rates).
- 8) If in the event a *retest* is necessary, the **certificate fee** will be refunded back to the individual in full. The non-refundable **test fee** (\$25) is retained for each testing attempt.
- 9) A <u>minimum</u> of two seminars and a Summer Camp within a 12 month period, is required to qualify for dan promotion.

These protocols are designed to eliminate any confusion and to more efficiently process all aspects of test procedures. Being considered for promotion is stressful enough; we want all clerical elements of testing to be clear, organized and without errors. – Thank you!...

-- Test Program & Requirements --

General Notes: *"Minimum length of training..."* referes to the number of years the candidate has been practicing <u>since their start date</u>. Extenuating circumstances of years spent on leave from regular training will be discussed with Sensei Mitsuzuka and Shihan Wehrhahn.

The test candidate will both be allowed to <u>choose</u> and be <u>assigned</u> kata to present.

"# Kata of Discression" referes to the number of kata the candidate can expect to be assigned by the judges on the day of the test.

Shodan:	Minimum length of required training:	2 years

	# Kata of Choice:	2

Know basic behaviors and correct sequence of movements within selected kata. Demonstrate your 5 kata in proper order as they are practiced in the Omori Ryu.

*** *Junto* is the technique to assist *Seppuku* (*Harakiri* suicide), and <u>is not to be performed</u> in promotional testing *as an unwritten rule*. This applies to all Dan tests *except* when the entirety of Shoden is required to be performed as a criterian for certain levels.

	Mandatory Kata:	Shohatto, Batto

Display a refined understanding of the events in each kata. Show strong spirit, composure and *zanshin*. Demonstrate your 7 kata in proper order as they are practiced in the Omori Ryu.
